

AAI Privacy Statement

The American Association of Immunologists, Inc. (AAI) is concerned about the privacy of visitors to the www.IMMUNOLOGY2010.org website and the confidentiality of their information shared with us through the website. AAI will use reasonable efforts to ensure that the information visitors to the site provide remains private and is used only for the purposes stated below.

Information Collected during Abstract Submissions

To submit an abstract, authors must log onto the Abstract Submission Site (IMMUNOLOGY2010.abstractcentral.com). The submission form requires specific contact information, including name and email address. The submitter's contact information is used to enable AAI to contact an author as necessary and appropriate. Unique identifiers (such as user IDs and passwords) are collected to verify the user's identity and to use in confirming AAI member status of authors.

Disclosure of Information

It is our policy not to share the personal information collected through the abstract submission website with any third parties. AAI does not release authors' email addresses to outside organizations, including the Abstract Programming Committee. Note: the names of the authors, their institutions, and the text of the abstracts submitted will be published. AAI will divulge any information collected from authors on the website when required to do so by law.

Security Measures

Authors' information is password protected by AAI and should not be shared with anyone. The website has security measures in place to protect against the loss, misuse, and alteration of the information authors submit.

E-Commerce Security Practice

Maintaining the confidentiality of authors' personal information is important to AAI. Credit card numbers are used for the limited purpose of collecting the abstract submission fee. When an authors' credit card information is transmitted to the abstract submission site for validation, it is secured by encryption technology to ensure protection against unauthorized access to the authors' personal information. Financial information will in no way be used by or shared with any third parties unless the third party manages the billing for AAI.
